For an 18-year-old, getting a job in maintenance was a challenge but Nikhil is working very successfully as a skilled tradesman by utilizing his skills and knowledge in the right way. Nikhil monthly remuneration is 12000 per month with additional benefits of PF, ESIC and Hostel facility.
